Subject: Certificate of Honor of the school for the purpose of Section 18 of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, Rule 15 of 2016 Rule 15 (4) of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2001.

Sir/Madam,

Provisional recognition for three years from 1st to 8th class is issued to Sanskar School Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda under the request of AAP and subsequent correspondence with the school. The above accreditation is based on the following conditions:

- 1) Permission for recognition cannot be extended and in no case should it be taken to mean that it is compulsory for the accreditation beyond class VIII.
- 2) Follow the provisions of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education of School Children Act 2009 (Table 1) and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 101 Table-11). 3)
- 3) Enrollment of children in the first class or pre-school class (whichever is under previous school), 25 per cent of the total number of the class, children belonging to the weaker sections and the group having access to drinking water and free and compulsory basic education, its completion provide till the end of the year.
- 4) The expenses incurred in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Act shall be commemorated. The school will have to set up a separate bank account to repay this.
- 5) Institute/School will not charge any capitation fee and will not adopt any method of selection of the child or his / her parents or friends.
- 6) The school will not deny giving admission to any child without having birth proof and will abide by the provision of Section 15 of the Act.
- 7) It will be made sure by the school that:
 - a) No enrolled person will be kept back in the class or expelled from the school till the completion of basic education in his school.
 - b) No physical or mental relief will be given to any child.
 - c) No child will be required to pass any Board examination till completion of basic education.
 - d) Every child who has completed basic education will be given a certificate as per rule 25.
 - e) Involvement of students with special needs disabilities as per the provisions of the Act.

- f) Teachers are required to meet the minimum educational qualifications required under section 21 (1). The next condition for the son is that the existing teachers who do not meet the minimum educational qualifications at the time of implementation of this Act, will get the minimum educational qualifications within five years. Extend with teaching and non-teaching staff statements.
- g) Fulfill the responsibilities specified under Section 24 (1) of the Teachers Act.
- h) Teachers will not keep themselves famous in private tuitions.
- 8) Schools shall follow the syllabus prescribed by the appropriate undertaking on the basis of the subjects of study.
- 9) The school will comply with the conditions and standards laid down in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported during the previous inspection are as follows -
- (A) Area of the school campus
 - (B) Total building area
 - (C) Area of playground
 - (D) Counting of Classrooms
 - (E) Office cum store room for head teacher.
 - (F) Separate toilets for boys and girls
 - (G) Drinking water facility
 - (H) Kitchen for cooking mid-day food
 - (I) Approach, without obstacle
 - (J) Equipment for teaching and learning/ Equipment for games/library
- (10) No wall recognized classroom shall be run inside or outside the school building under the same name of the school.
- (11) School building or other structure or ground to be used for education and development only.
- (12) The school is being run by a society registered under section 219 of the School Societies Registration Act, 1960, or by a settlement created from time to time under any applicable law.
- (13) School will not be run for the personal benefits of any person, group or benefits for any other person.
- (14) The accounts should be audited by a certified chartered accountant and a statement of defense shall be prepared as per rules. A copy of each accounting table shall be sent to the District Education Officer.
- (15) The recognized code of your school is 704. It should be complied with and it should be recorded while dealing with this office.
- (16) Follow the instructions issued by the District Education Officer to meet the conditions of accreditation or to rectify the shortcomings in the functioning of the school.
- (17) Renewal of Registration of institution if any, laid to be compulsory.





- (18) Fire Safety Certificate and Building Safety After the expiry of the certificate, the certificate should be sent to this office again. If not so, the proceeding to cancel the recognition will be started.
- (19) Certificate of Medium and Speech
- (20) Copy of A-Roll of Salary to Teachers and Land Deeds (Mutation)
- (21) Map of School Building
- (22) List of Funds Received from Children and Staff at Government Rates.
- (23) List of Management Committee
- (24) If in future RTE. If the Act and rules are violated then RTE Appropriate action will be taken as per Act and rules.
